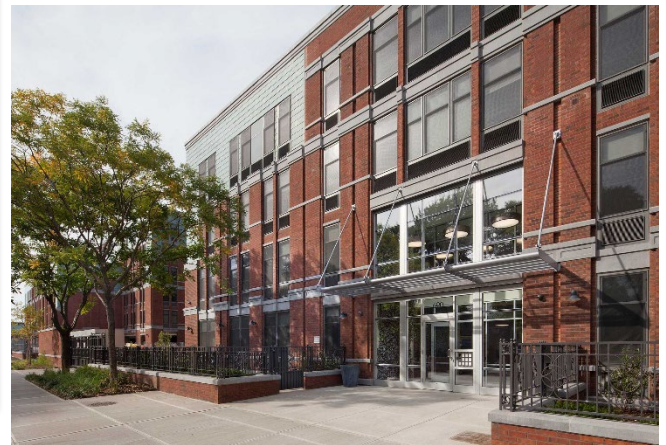


## HOSPITAL AND HOUSING

By partnering with major healthcare and hospital systems, CAMBA Gardens I & II were built on **unused Kings County Hospital property.**

Lowers public costs by reducing shelter and emergency room use by connecting people experiencing homelessness to housing and health services. This partnership delivers sustainable, affordable housing that prioritizes tenant health.

## CAMBA Housing Ventures

### Core Components

- Health supports include connection to healthcare services, health benefits advocacy, mental health wellbeing groups, health and wellness programming
- Other supportive services including financial literacy and other economic development services, training on computer skills, workshops on key topics such as resume development and nutrition, connections to job training, and education and youth development supports.
- Amenities include communal kitchens, resident gardening beds, landscaped outdoor space, outdoor play areas, community rooms, and computer labs.
