A PLACE TO HEAL

Denver, CO

Recuperative care facility with 75 medical respite beds that provides a safe, high-quality environment for people experiencing homelessness to recover from medical or clinical treatment in a way that is not possible in shelters or on the streets.

Improves health outcomes by helping people heal and stabilize, and reduces costs by shortening hospital stays and preventing unnecessary emergency room use and hospital readmissions.

Core Components

- Clients receive 24-hour supervised care, medical care, hygiene supplies, meals from an on-site kitchen, laundry access, and use of community spaces and on-site programming.
- Other supports include a pharmacy, behavioral health services, substance use treatment, peer support, and job training. Case managers and housing counselors work with clients to plan for moving on to long-term housing after discharge.
- Co-located with a 98-unit supportive housing development which houses people who were experiencing homelessness with high utilization of emergency rooms and hospitals.
