St. Bartholomew's LIFE Center followed the national PACE (Program of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly) model, which provides robust, coordinated care and services in the community to enable older adults who need nursing home-level care to safely remain at home, maintain their health, and preserve their independence.

Improves quality of life and health for older adults and reduces costs by avoiding unnecessary placement in costly settings including nursing homes or other care facilities.



New Courtland LIFE Program

Core Components

- Offers on-site healthcare services such as primary care, dentistry, specialty care, physical\occupational\speech therapy, pharmacy services, home health nursing care, and more.
- Offers supportive services such as home modifications, transportation, meals, adult day care, nutrition and wellness programming, personal care services, and social activities and outings.
- Co-located with 48 units of supportive housing for people 62 years and older with incomes at or below 20% of Area Median Income.
